Brian will share his personal experiences as an army officer in Afghanistan, as well as his time leading Aman Lara, the organization of veterans and former interpreters who banded together to help Afghans escape the Taliban after the fall of Kabul in 2021. 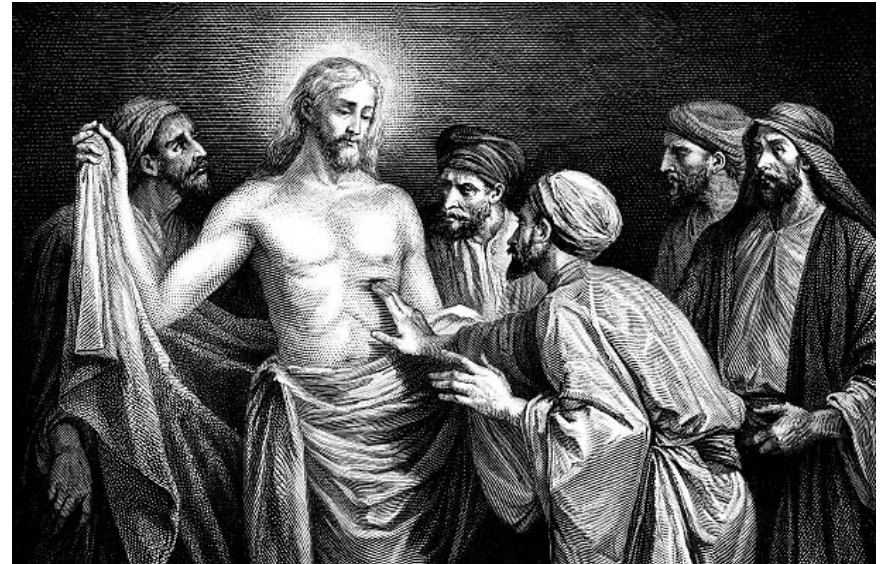
